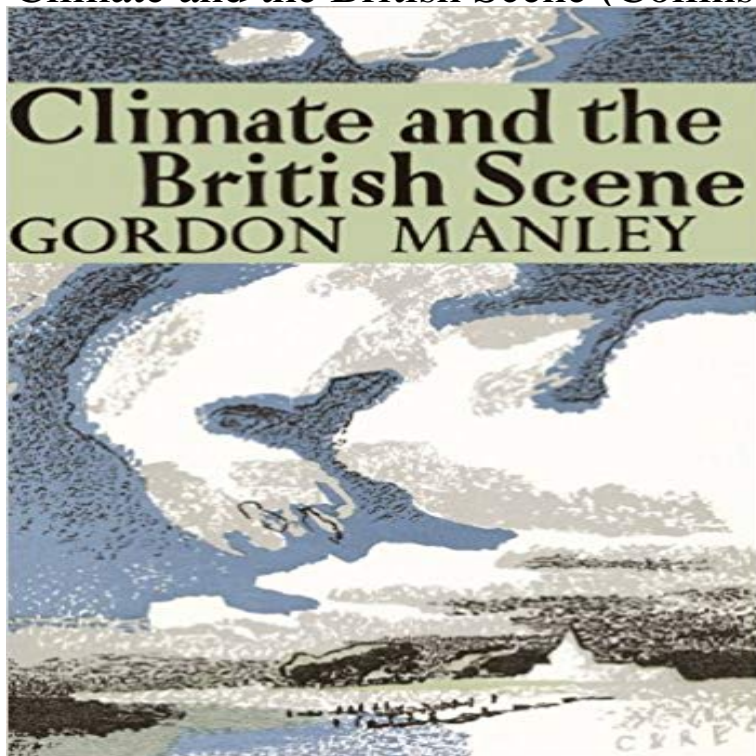

It may justly be claimed that this is the first book to attempt scientifically to trace these intimate yet elusive relationships.
