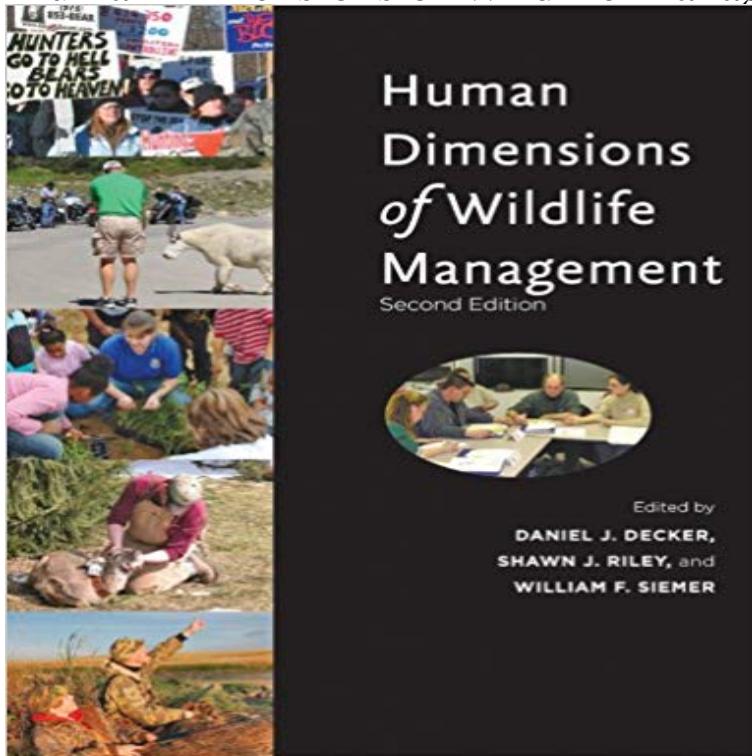


Human Dimensions of Wildlife Management
