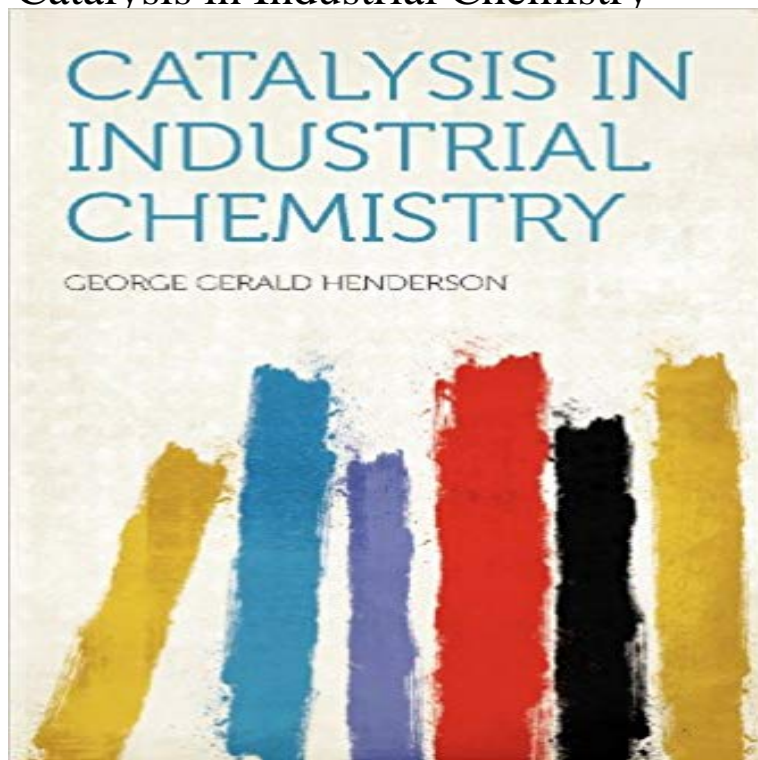


Catalysis in Industrial Chemistry
