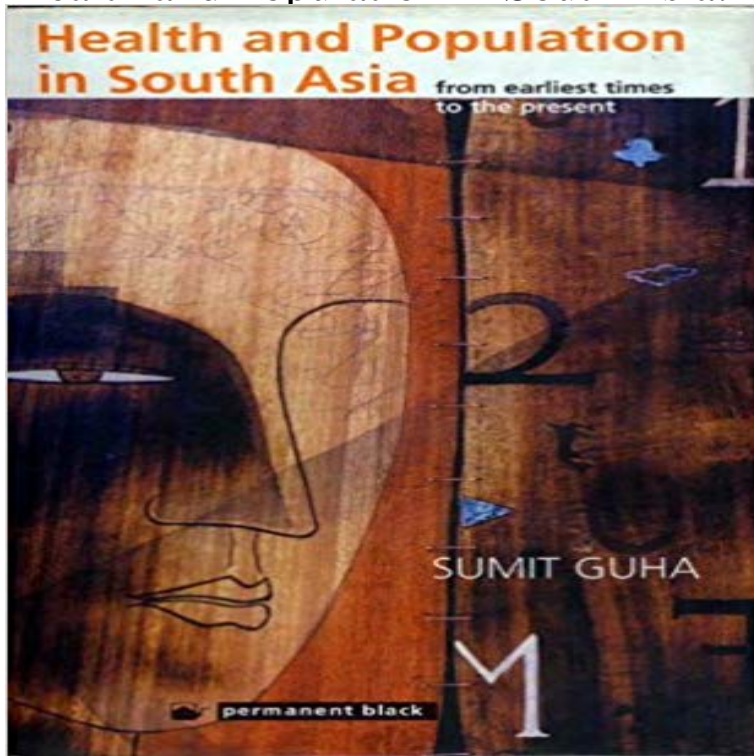


Health and Population in South Asia: From earliest times to the present
