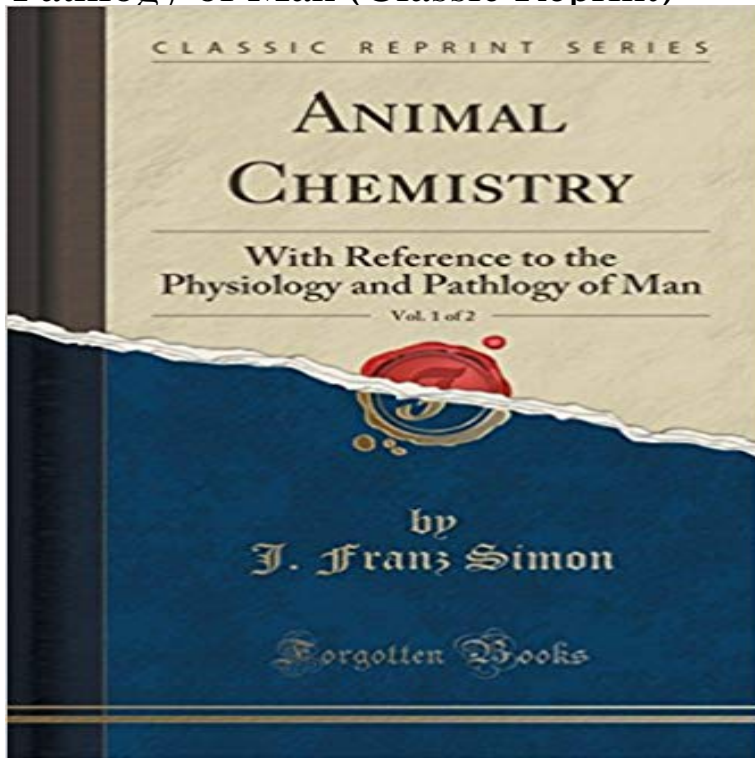


Animal Chemistry, Vol. 1 of 2: With Reference to the Physiology and Pathology of Man (Classic Reprint)



Excerpt from Animal Chemistry, Vol. 1 of 2: With Reference to the Physiology and Pathology of Man I have much pleasure in presenting to the members of the Sydenham Society a translation of Simons Chemistry of Man, a work that obtained for its author a European reputation, and is universally regarded as by far the most complete treatise that has yet appeared on Physiological Chemistry. Until I became acquainted with this work in 1843, I entertained the idea of publishing a text-book of medical chemistry with the view of attempting to supply a deficiency in the medical literature of this country, which, I doubt not, has been felt by many of my brethren as much as by myself. But a careful perusal of the Chemistry of Man convinced me that I should be doing better service to the profession by undertaking a translation of that work than by the publication of a separate treatise. Impressed with this feeling I wrote to the author, who immediately offered me all the assistance in his power, and promised me a considerable amount of original matter. I regret to say that his early and unexpected death in the autumn of the same year rendered this promise of comparatively little value.
