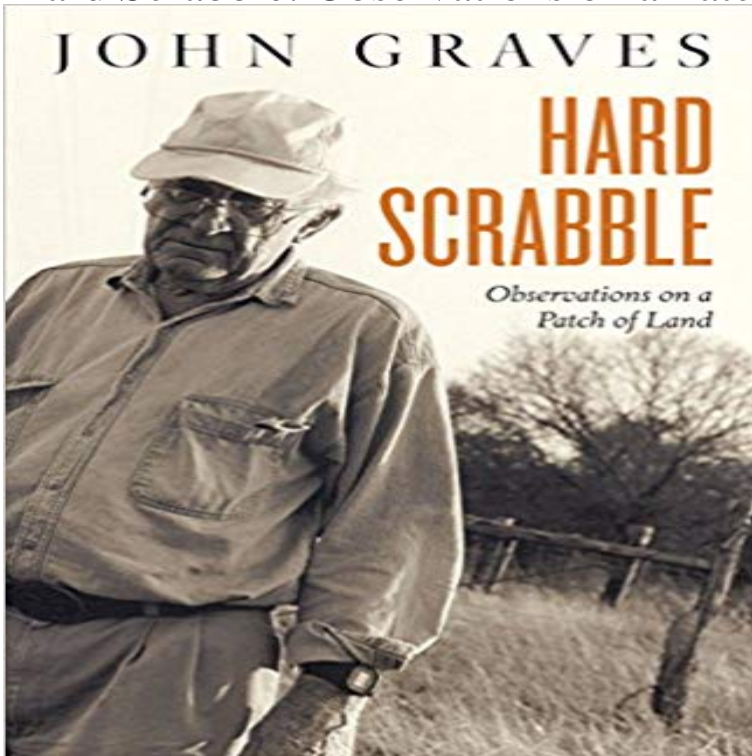


## Hard Scrabble: Observations on a Patch of Land
