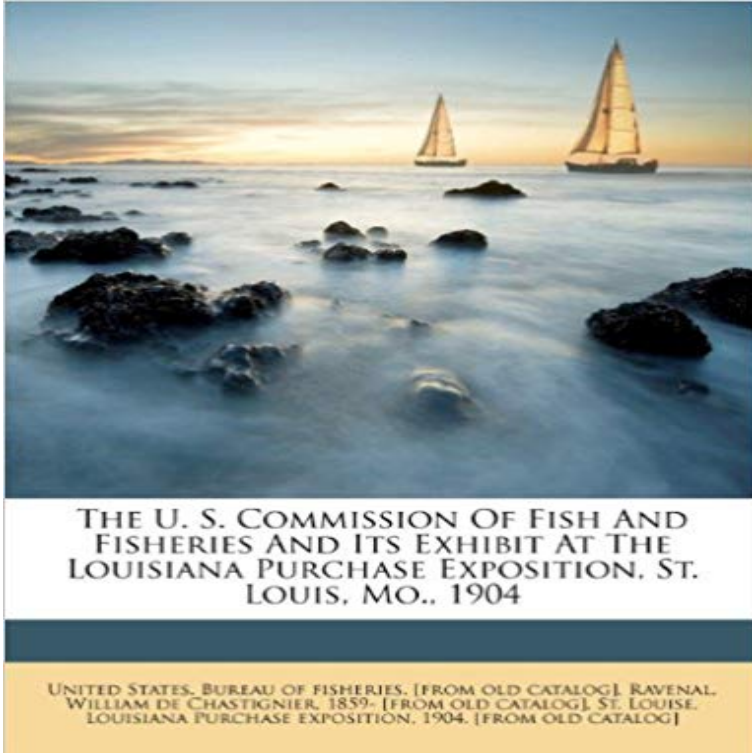


# The U. S. Commission of Fish and Fisheries and Its Exhibit at the Louisiana Purchase Exposition, St. Louis, Mo., 1904
