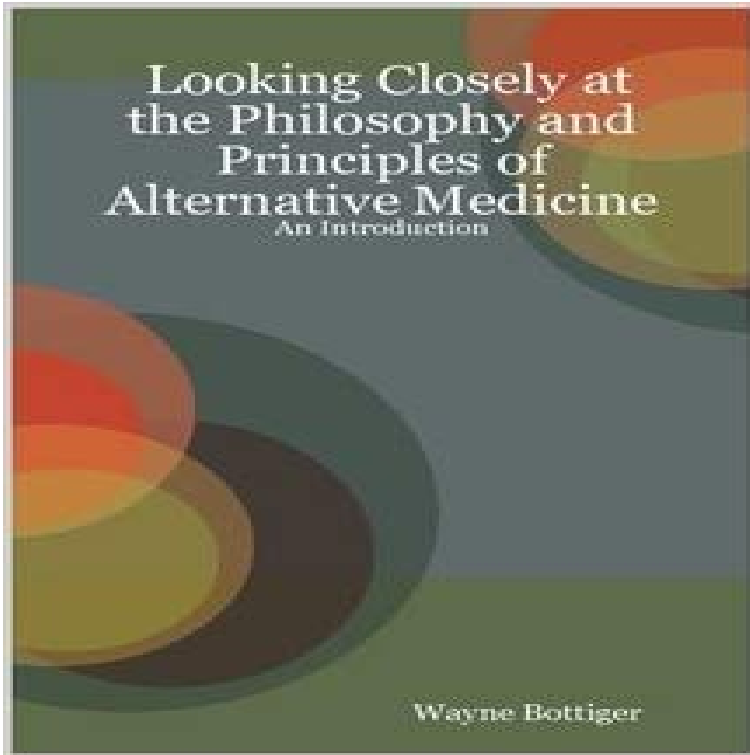


Looking Closely at the Philosophy and Principles of Alternative Medicine - An Introduction
