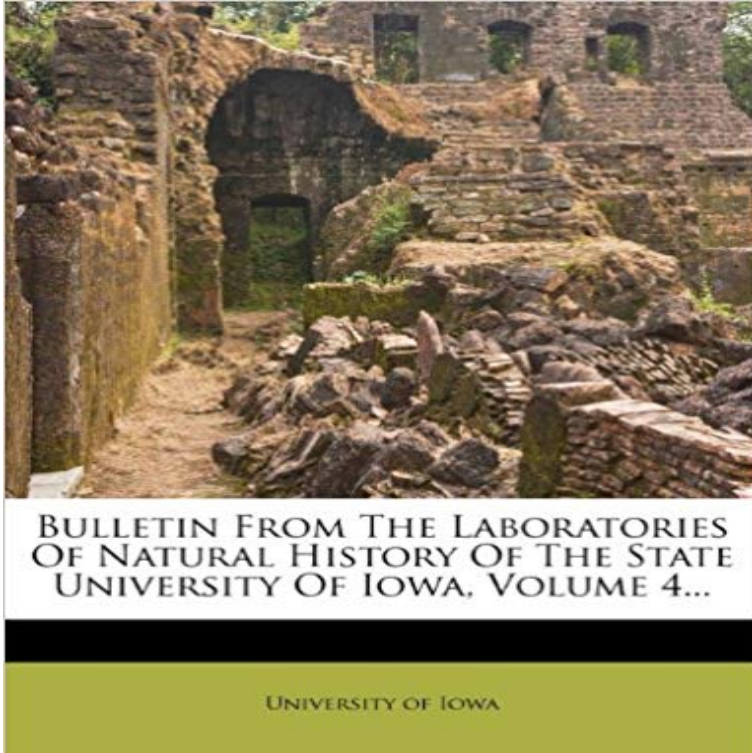


## Bulletin from the Laboratories of Natural History of the State University of Iowa, Volume 4...
