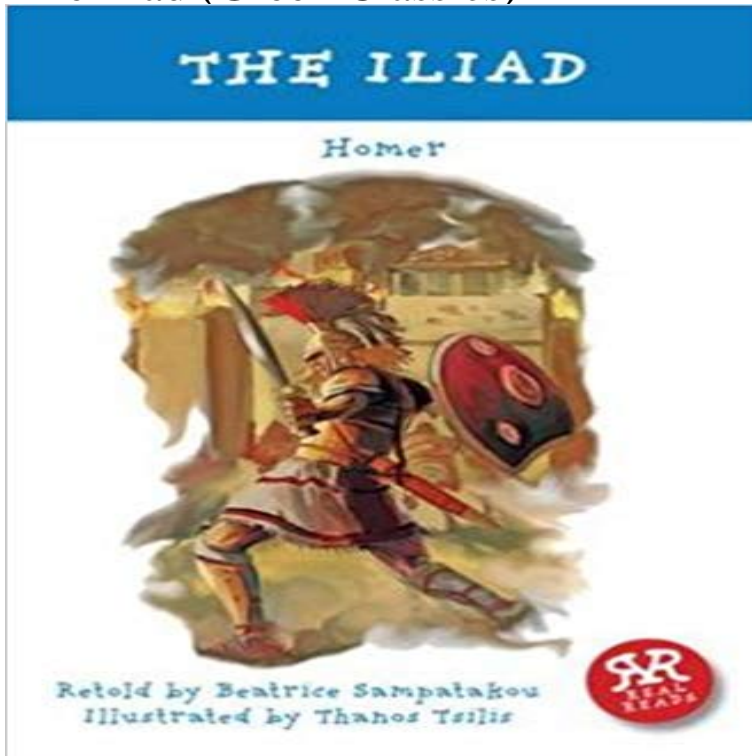


The Iliad (Greek Classics)
