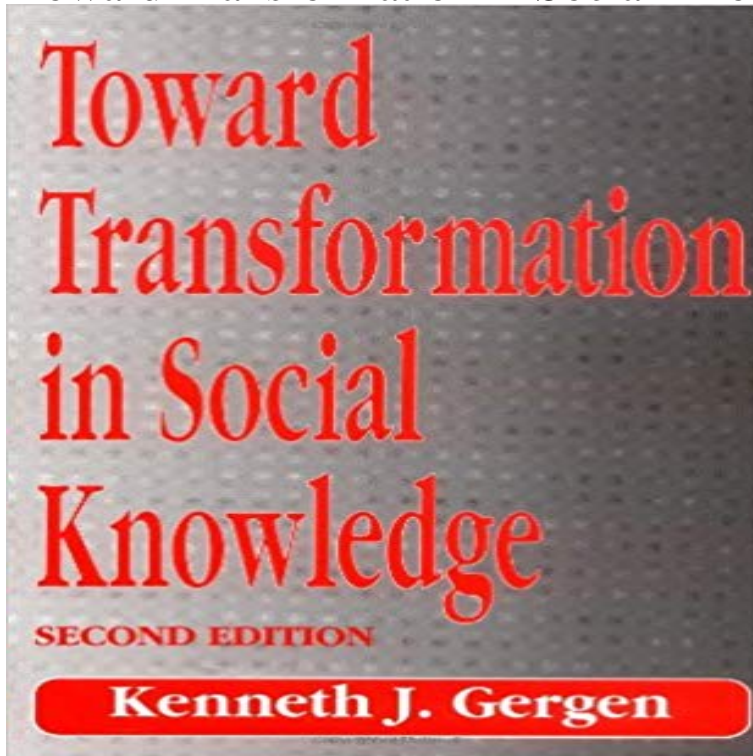


Toward Transformation in Social Knowledge
